

Addendum to the CALL FOR PAPER SP2020

ORGANISATION OF A PROSPECTIVE SESSION : IN SITU RESOURCES UTILIZATION (ISRU) AND SPACE PROPULSION

EUCASS joins 3AF to organize during SpacePropulsion2020 a prospective session: "In Situ Resources Utilization and Space Propulsion"

Please take good note that consequently a new topic is added to SP2020 Call for Papers.

In-situ resource utilization (ISRU) is a key element for increasing sustainability for Moon and Mars exploration success.

The aim is to present to the largest audience some possibilities of In Situ Resources Utilization and discuss if specific needs relative to Space Propulsion could be satisfied in situ. (propellant and consumable manufacturing, energy ...)

The session will be followed by a round table in order to identify if some new directions of research could be relevant.

Contributors will have to create their account, register and upload their abstracts on SP2020 platform with respect to the same rules and deadlines as stipulated in SP2020 Call for papers already issued.

The following advice to authors are reminded :

- The main purpose of the abstract is to give the Technical Committee information to assist them in selecting the papers to be presented at the conference.
- The selected papers will be presented in a 20 minutes speech at the conference (+ 5 minutes for Q&A).
- An abstract will be selected based on the importance and originality of the subject addressed, on its relevance to the conference theme, on the clarity of its expression.
- The abstract should be a "stand alone" summary that can be used in the compilation of abstracts.
- The abstract should be in English and no longer than 500 words.
- The abstract should summarize the main objectives of the paper to be presented and outline its conclusions.
- Work that has been presented elsewhere, and not updated, will be considered inappropriate.
- All abstracts should be submitted on www.spacepropulsion2020.com

Notification of Acceptance/Refusal

The organizing committee will notify all authors of its decision on 23 March 2020. This notification will be accompanied by detailed instructions allowing authors to prepare and send their paper to the 3AF secretariat by 20 July 2020.

Please note that failure to comply with the deadline will entail not having the manuscript included in the conference proceedings.

Language

Please note that the official language for the conference will be English.

All presentations and documents must be in English.
